	→ She likes pizza.



Structure

Affirmative

- Subject + base verb (+s/es for he/she/it)
 Examples:
- I play football.
- He plays football.

X Negative

- Subject + don't/doesn't + base verb Examples:
- I don't like tea.
- She doesn't like tea.

? Questions

- Do/Does + subject + base verb?
 Examples:
- Do you study English?
- Does he live here?



- Spelling Rules for Third Person (he/she/it):
 - Add -s → She runs
 - Add -es for verbs ending in -ch, -sh, -ss, -x, -o
 → He watches TV.
 - Drop the -y and add -ies if there's a consonant before the "y"

 → She studies English.
- 🧠 Time Expressions Often Used:
 - Always, usually, often, sometimes, never
 - Every day/week/month
 - On Mondays, in the morning, at night
